Today we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Presentation of the Lord.** In the Gospel story today, Mary and Joseph present the infant Jesus in the Temple with a sacrifice of a pair of turtle doves. Simeon was present and had been told by the Holy Spirit that he would see the promised Messiah before his own death. Upon seeing the infant Jesus, Simeon rejoices, "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace...for my eyes have seen your salvation." Yet this salvation will be accompanied through great suffering. Simeon prepares Mary, "and you yourself a sword will pierce", anticipating the suffering she will experience when her Son dies upon the Cross. We see in this one story both great rejoicing and great suffering. Such is the Paschal Mystery of our faith.
