

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Today we celebrate the **12th Sunday in Ordinary Time**. We hear today the story of Jesus calming the storm on the sea. During the storm Jesus was asleep on a cushion in the stern. "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" There may be moments in our own lives when we might wonder if Jesus cares about the storms that surround us. Why is He sleeping? The key is always to have faith, to continue pondering the question, "*Who then is this* whom even the wind and sea obey?"

We are looking for 4-5 volunteers each month to **Wash and Iron our Sacramental Purificators**. The purificators are the white cloths which Communion Ministers use to purify the cup after members have received the Precious Blood of our Lord. We currently have 3 volunteers... **needing just 1-2 more volunteers!** Each person would only need to provide this ministry one time per month. Please let me know if you are interested in assisting in this ministry.

Finally, Blessed Sacrament Parish is planning a **Bus Trip to a Cardinals Game on Friday evening, July 26**. ***St. Therese of Lisieux's Prayer for Priests***


O Jesus, eternal Priest,

**12<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

*“Then he asked them, ‘Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?’” – Mark 4:40*

Do you really trust God? Is God your first choice or last resort? Is your faith something you just do on Sunday or do you live the Gospel message every day of the week? Many of us know about God. How many of us have a personal relationship with Him? Start now, open your heart to receive our Lord. Talk and listen to Him every day. Move your discipleship from head knowledge to heart knowledge.

**Wednesday Evening 5:30 p.m. Mass now being celebrated Ad Orientem.**

**What does that mean and why does it matter?**

What?

Ad Orientem—This Ecclesiastical Latin phrase is commonly used to describe a particular posture of a priest in Christian liturgy: facing away from the people towards the apse or reredos or wall behind the altar, with priest and people looking in the same direction, as opposed to the *versus populum* orientation in which the priest faces the congregation.

Why?

Why would anyone prefer Mass where the priest faces away from the congregation? The key consideration given by those arguing for this, who include prominent theologians such as Cdl. Joseph Ratzinger, before his election as Pope Benedict XVI, and Cdl. Christoph Schönborn, in a book he wrote in 1996, can be expressed as a question: to whom are the prayers of the Mass, particularly the Eucharistic Prayer, addressed? If they are addressed to God, then it makes sense for the celebrant to say them toward something symbolizing God, in union with the people. Historically, this has been the East: the direction of the rising sun. Even if the church is not in line with the geographical East, the direction of the altar from the nave can be regarded as symbolizing the East, and priest and people can direct their gaze, and their prayers, toward it, together.


