

Our Lady of Champion

Feast Day October 9, 2024



Our Lady of Champion is the first Marian apparition approved by the Church in the United States. Our Lady appeared to a Belgian immigrant—Adele Brise—three times in the year 1859. Each time, she appeared between two trees, dressed in dazzling white. The final apparition—on October 9—was the most moving. Adele, who had promised earlier in life to become a nun, was walking with her sister and a friend, but they couldn't see the apparition. Adele fell to the ground and asked Our Lady: "In God's name, who are you, and what do you want of me?"


