

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the **29th Sunday of Ordinary Time**. In the gospel story today the apostles John and James request a special favor from Jesus. At Christ's coming in glory they wish "that we may sit one at your right and the other at your left." James and John envision the Messiah coming with great royal power. Jesus envisions the Messiah looking more like a Suffering Servant. "For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to *give his life for the ransom of many.*" Similarly we find our own visions evolving with our growth in discipleship.

This weekend I give my **Witness Talk in preparation for our annual Stewardship Sunday next Saturday/Sunday October 26-27**. Hopefully you have all received your Blessed Sacrament Stewardship booklet in the mail. Please take a few minutes to review your booklet, and fill out your current and desired parish activities. We ask you to either mail back your Stewardship form to the Parish Office, or return it to the designated location in the Gathering Space next Sunday. Thank you for your gift of stewardship to our Lord here at Blessed Sacrament Parish.

Next weekend (October 26/27) our Parish Haiti Committee will present their **Annual Financial Report on monies given through our monthly Haiti Sister Parish 2nd Collection**. Haiti Committee Chairperson Joe Bordewick will have both a written and verbal report to give to all of us on how our monies are being spent for our Sister Parish of St. Antoine in Haiti. I thank our entire Haiti Committee for their continued good work in communicating with our Sister Parish and giving us all continued direction on how best to support our Sister Parish of St. Antoine.

In two weeks - **Saturday, November 2 at 9:00 a.m.** - we will celebrate our annual **Mass of Remembrance**. We invite parish members to attend who have lost a loved one during the past year. We ask the Lord to bring the fullness of eternal life to all who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith.

Finally, on **Saturday, November 16** our parish is hosting a **Day Trip to visit the Abbey of Our Lady of Ephesus in Gower, MO**. This abbey was founded by Sr. Wilhemina Lancaster, who died in 2019, and whose body was found incorrupt when it was exhumed in April 2023. During our day trip we will attend Mass with the Benedictine Sisters at 11:00 a.m., followed by lunch and short tour of the abbey grounds. **Cost of the trip is \$30.00 per person** (made payable to Blessed Sacrament) plus bringing along your own lunch. Please contact the Parish Office right away to sign up for the trip. We will need a minimum of 16 people in order to take 2 vans, otherwise our maximum will be 12 persons for one van. Deadline for registration is **Friday, November 8**.
