

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Today we celebrate the **24<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**. In the gospel story this weekend we hear the climactic moment in Mark's narrative when Peter proclaims Jesus as the Messiah and Christ. All of Jesus' miracles and exorcisms have led Peter to the conviction that Jesus truly is the awaited Messiah. Yet Peter is not prepared for what kind of messiah with which our Lord is identifying. Jesus will be a messiah who must *suffer*. How is the suffering in my own life leading me to the Messiah?

This weekend (September 14/15) is **Catechetical Sunday**. This weekend the universal Church recognizes and blesses all those involved in sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ in many varied parish and school ministries. Here at Blessed Sacrament at all weekend Masses we will honor and bless leaders and participants in the following parish/school catechetical ministries:

- Blessed Sacrament School Faculty & Staff
- PSR Catechists      -Children's Liturgy of the Word
- RCIA Team            -Pre Cana Team/ Marriage Preparation
- Quincy Spirit Team   -Vacation Bible School Leaders

This week I will be in Collinsville, Illinois, for our **Annual Diocesan Priests Convocation**. The priests of our diocese gather annually for 3 days of continuing education and formation. This year we will hear presentations by **Dr. Edward Sri on "Making Missionary Disciples in the Parish."**

Next weekend (September 21/22) our Parish Finance Council will present the **2023-24 Annual Parish/School Financial Report**. I thank the members of the Finance Council for their continued outstanding leadership in managing the financial resources of our parish and school. Written reports will be presented next weekend, along with a brief presentation by members of the Finance Council.

I would like to thank the Quincy Catholic Elementary Schools (QCES) Foundation Board for the **\$38,420 that they have disbursed this 2024-25 academic year to 18 Blessed Sacrament School families** in Tuition Assistance. This year QCES has awarded \$130,000 total to Quincy area Catholic families, which is more than \$25,000 more than was disbursed the year prior. I would like to thank the QCES Foundation Board and Executive Director Sara Reuschel for their great leadership work in raising these Tuition Assistance funds for our Catholic School families. And thanks to all who have and continue to donate to QCES for the Tuition Assistance needs of Catholic families throughout our Quincy area. Thank you QCES!




