

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Today we celebrate the **26<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**. In the gospel story Jesus chastises the apostles for their narrow mindedness. Someone outside the Twelve was found doing mighty deeds in Jesus' name, and the apostles are not happy about it. Jesus says, "Do not prevent him...For whoever is not against us is for us." It is important to recognize the destructive impact that competitiveness can have on our mission. Competitiveness is good when it brings out the best in ourselves and in our "teams". It is destructive when we find ourselves competing with others who share the same good mission. The key is in knowing who our teammates are, and to strive to work with them rather than against them.

Next weekend Blessed Sacrament will begin our **October Count** of all persons attending Mass on the weekends of October. These numbers assist the Springfield Diocese in their continued efforts of pastoral planning.




