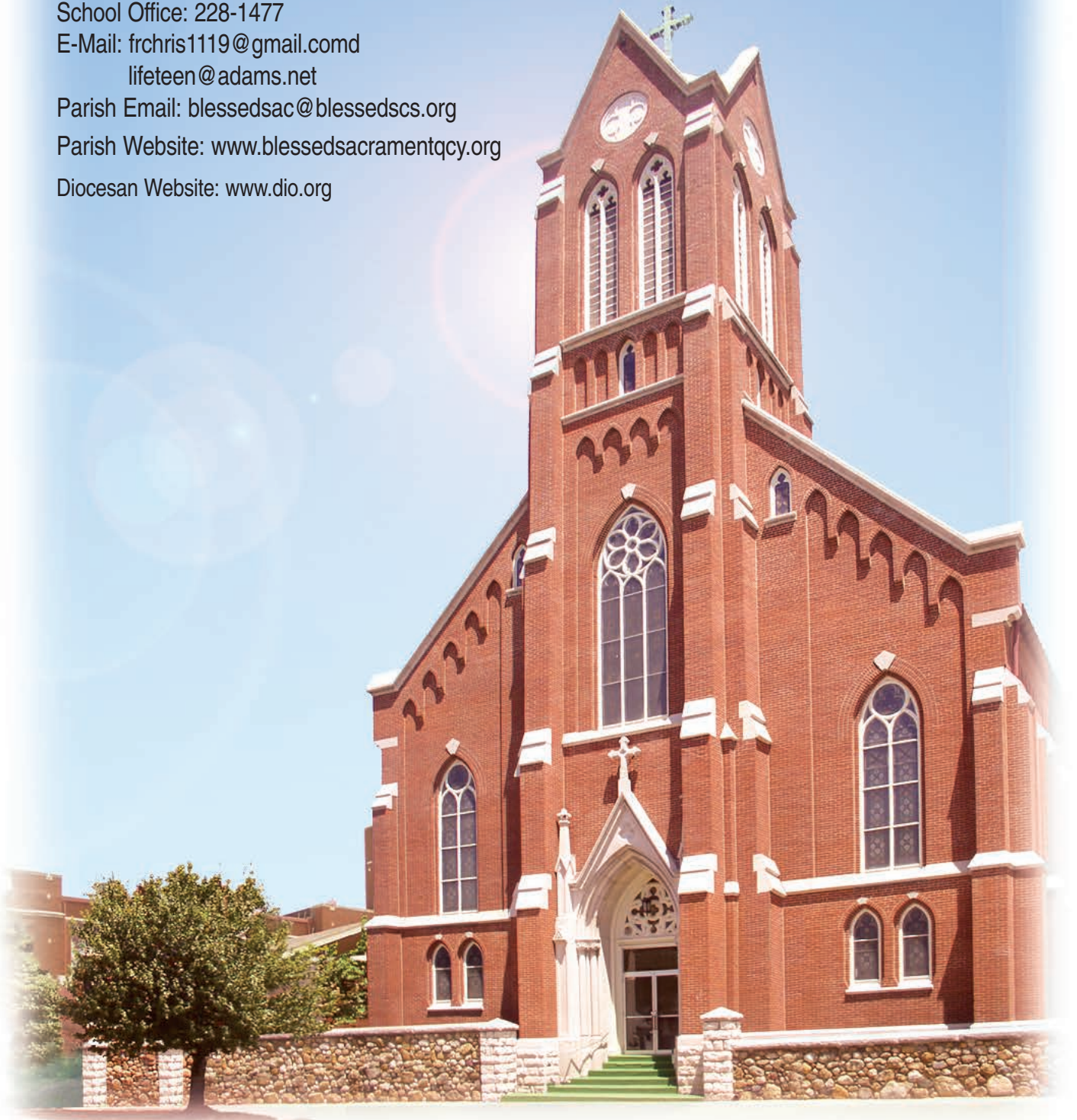

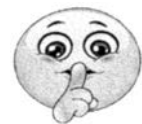

Grief Support Group

Those who have lost a loved one, be it a family member or a friend through death, is invited to join a Grief Share group which is being held at St. Anthony of Padua Parish. Grief Share is a 13-week, Christ-centered, Biblically based support group. A grieving person can join at any time during the 13 weeks. Each session shows a video. The Grief Share videos present experts, ministers and Christian counselors discussing grief and recovery subjects helpful to people in grief. Real people share their stories of what has helped them deal with the pain of losing a family member or friend through death. Trained facilitators assist the discussion. During the week between meetings, group members complete a daily Bible study and practical exercises to help them heal from grief.

Grief Share meets at St. Anthony Parish Hall each Thursday for 13 weeks beginning August 17 at 6:00 p.m. You are welcome to begin attending at any point. Each session is “self-contained,” so you do not have to attend in sequence. You will be able to pick up any session you missed in our next 13 week cycle. **There is no cost.**
