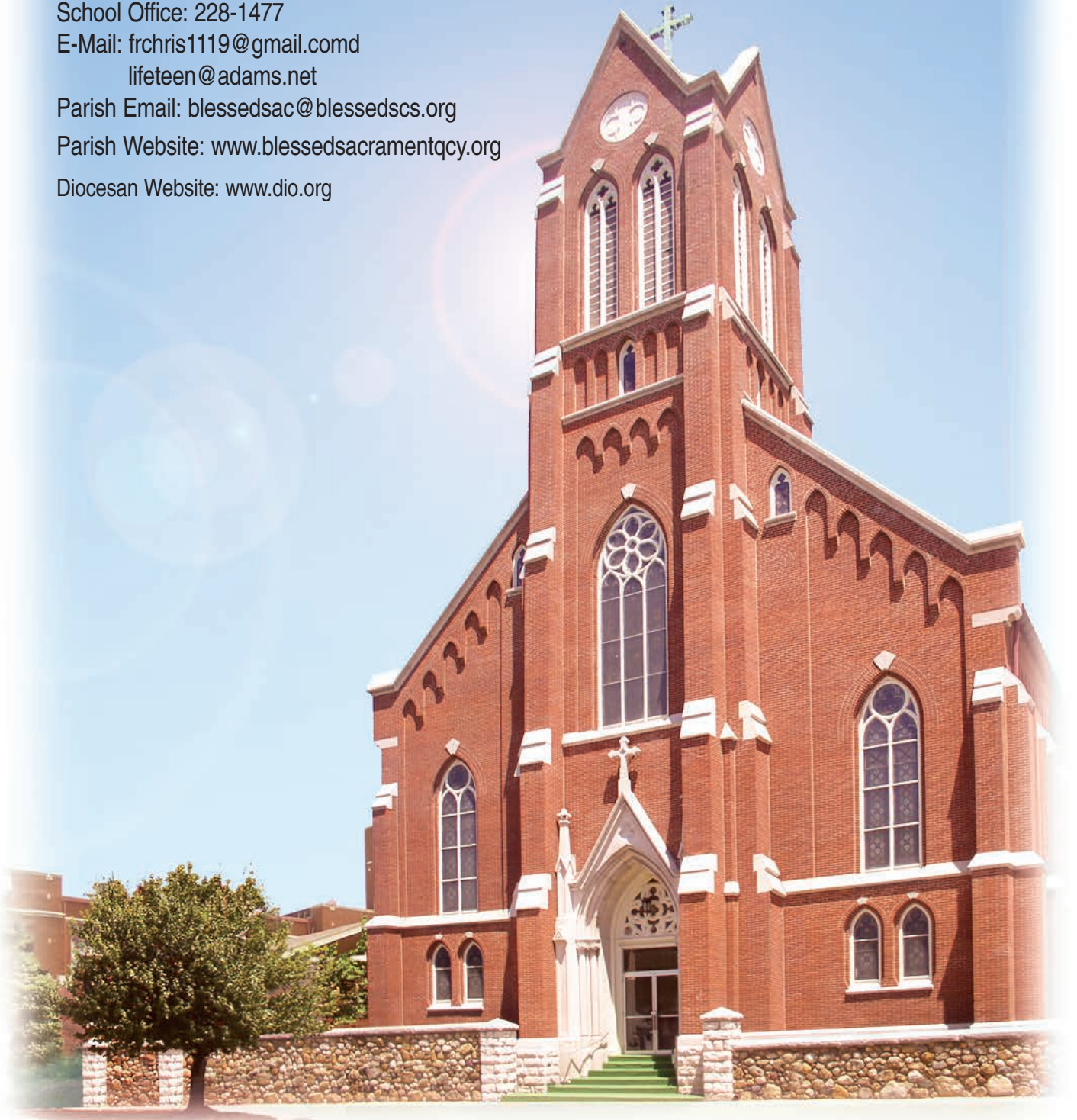

Another tradition I am bringing back is the ringing of the hand bells during the Consecration of the Mass. Hearing the bells draws us deeper into the mystery we are celebrating with all our senses.
