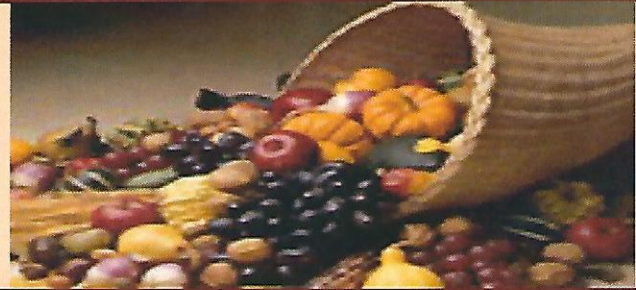


# Laudato Si' Daily Reflections Calendar (November 1 — November 30, 2018)
