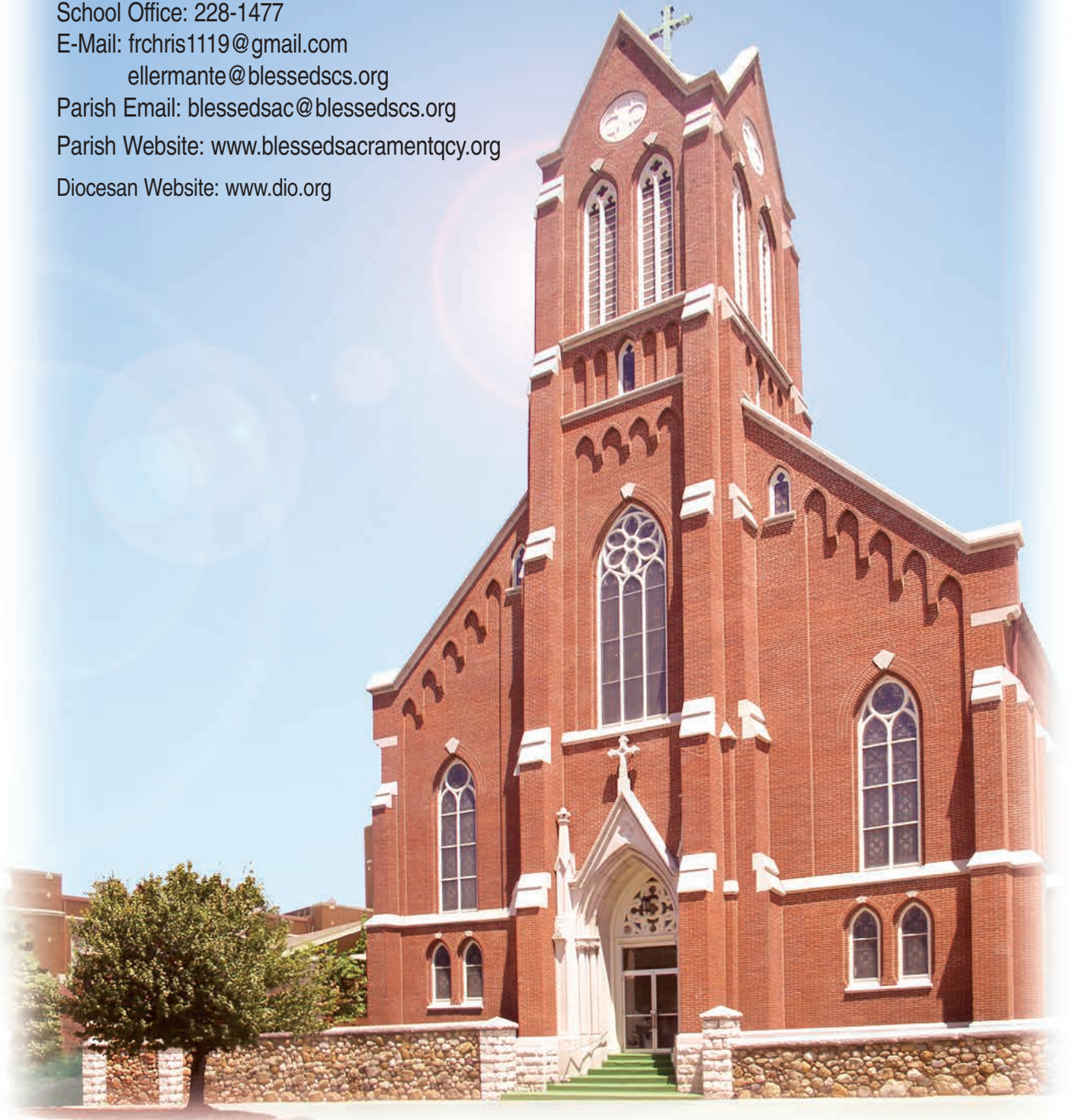

**FATHER CHRIS'S COLUMN**

**COLD AND FLU SEASON**

Bishop Paprocki sent a reminder to all the parishes about being careful to avoid the spreading of germs during the winter. If you have any symptoms of being sick, please avoid drinking from the chalice. You do receive the fullness of Jesus when you receive the host, so be careful not to drink when you may be contagious for others. You may also want to avoid shaking hands at the sign of peace or holding hands during the Our Father. You can acknowledge your neighbor with eye contact and a nod of the head or a wave and just say you are sick.

**MARCH FOR LIFE**

I will be in Washington, D.C. from Wednesday to Friday for this annual march to protest the Supreme Court decision that allowed the killing of children in the womb. I will concelebrate at the Vigil Mass held at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. This Mass will be televised on EWTN at 4:30 Quincy time. I will be at Mass on Friday morning at St. Peter Church on Capitol Hill with Bishop Paprocki and the people from the Diocese of Springfield. I will march with the students from Fr. McGivney Catholic High School. I will be back in the parish Saturday morning.

**MASS TO PRAY FOR LIFE**

The Bishops of the United States have asked us to pray and fast for the protection of all human life on Monday, January 22. I will have a special Mass that evening at 6:30 p.m. Everyone is welcome.

## **ANNOUNCEMENT OF EASTER AND THE MOVABLE FEASTS FOR 2018**

The proclamation of the date of Easter and the other movable feasts on Epiphany dates from a time when calendars were not readily available. It was necessary to make known the date of Easter in advance, since many celebrations of the liturgical year depend on its date. The number of Sundays that follow Epiphany, the date of Ash Wednesday, and the number of Sundays that follow Pentecost are all computed in relation to Easter.

Although calendars now give the date of Easter and the other feasts in the liturgical year for many years in advance, the Epiphany proclamation still has a value. It is a reminder of the centrality of the resurrection of the Lord in the liturgical year and the importance of the great mysteries of faith which are celebrated each year.

Each year the proper dates for Ash Wednesday, Easter, Ascension, Pentecost, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, and the First Sunday of Advent must be inserted into the text.

## **THE PROCLAMATION**

**Know, dear brethren (brothers and sisters),  
that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ  
So by leave of God's Mercy  
We announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection  
Who is our Savior,  
On the fourteenth day of February will fall on Ash Wednesday,  
And the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.  
On the first day of April, you will celebrate with joy Easter Day,  
The Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

**(In those places where the Ascension is observed on Thursday:  
On the tenth day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.)**

**(In those places where the Ascension is transferred to the Seventh Sunday of Easter:  
On the thirteenth day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.)**

**On the twentieth day of May, the feast of Pentecost.  
On the third day of June the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.**

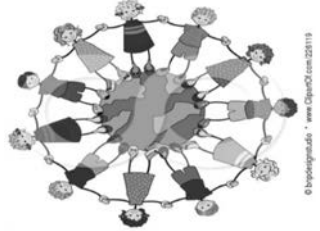
