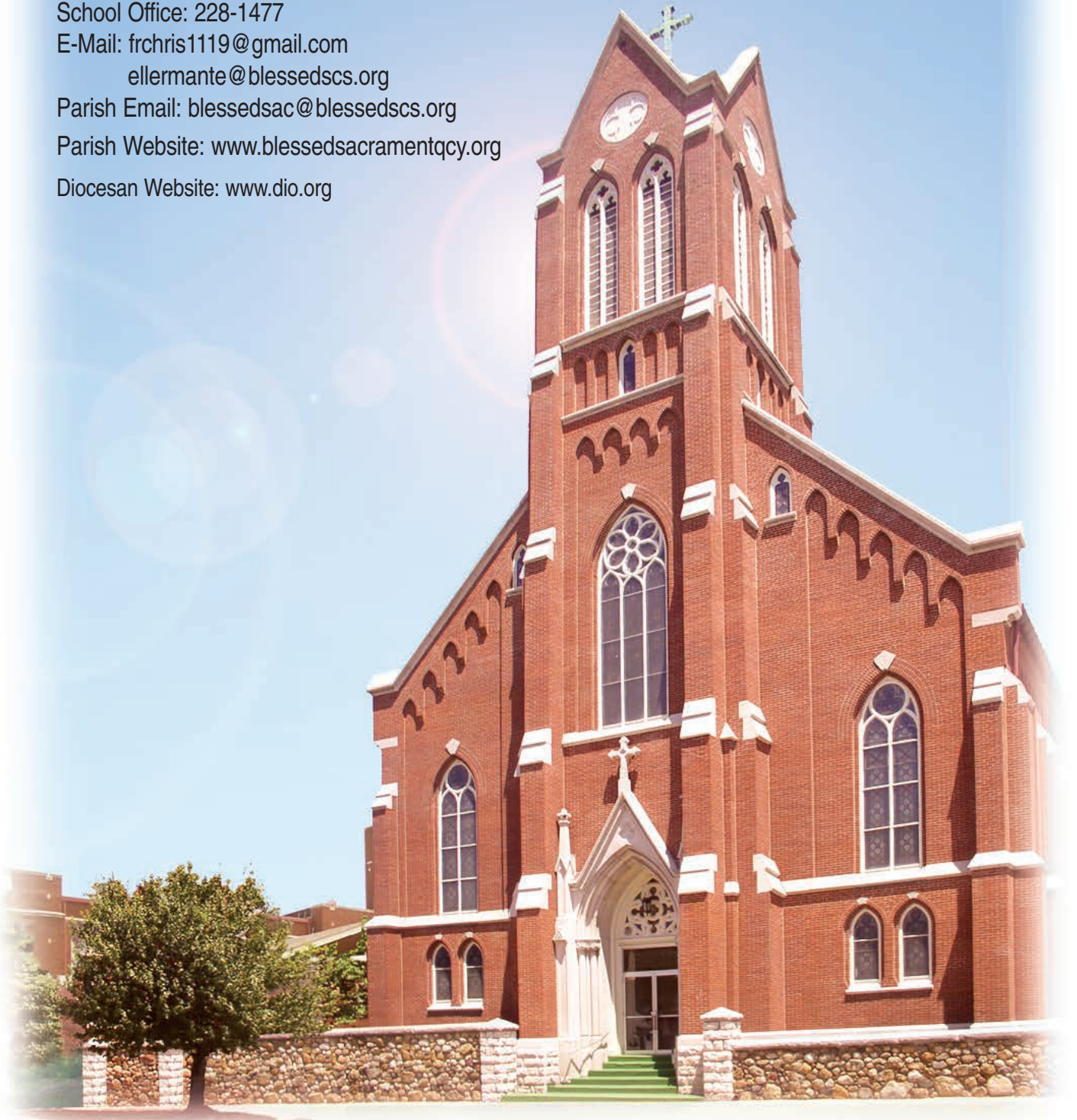

Next weekend I will be the Spiritual Director for Cursillo 334. Several members of our parish are on the team including Laurie Brink as Rectora. Please keep the team and candidates in your prayers.

**DIVINE MERCY**

Thanks for your positive response to our celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday. There are prayer cards with the image as well as pamphlets explaining how to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at all of the doors. I encourage you to make this part of your prayer life, especially if you are struggling to forgive someone.

**I NEED YOUR HELP**

One of our biggest challenges is our assessment for the Annual Catholic Services Appeal. As a parish in the Diocese of Springfield we have an obligation to assist the work of our Bishop and the offices under him. We also have to support the education and formation of our future priests. Our assessment for this year is just about \$80,000. We have collected about \$46,000 of this from 165 families. Giving directly to this appeal benefits the parish in the greatest way. The money collected directly is not assessed for the future. The money has to be collected by the end of April. We budgeted for about a \$25,000 shortfall so right now we are almost \$10,000 short of that. I will give another \$500 on top of the \$1,500 I have already donated. Envelopes are in the pews to help with this. Thanks for considering helping with this by the end of April.
