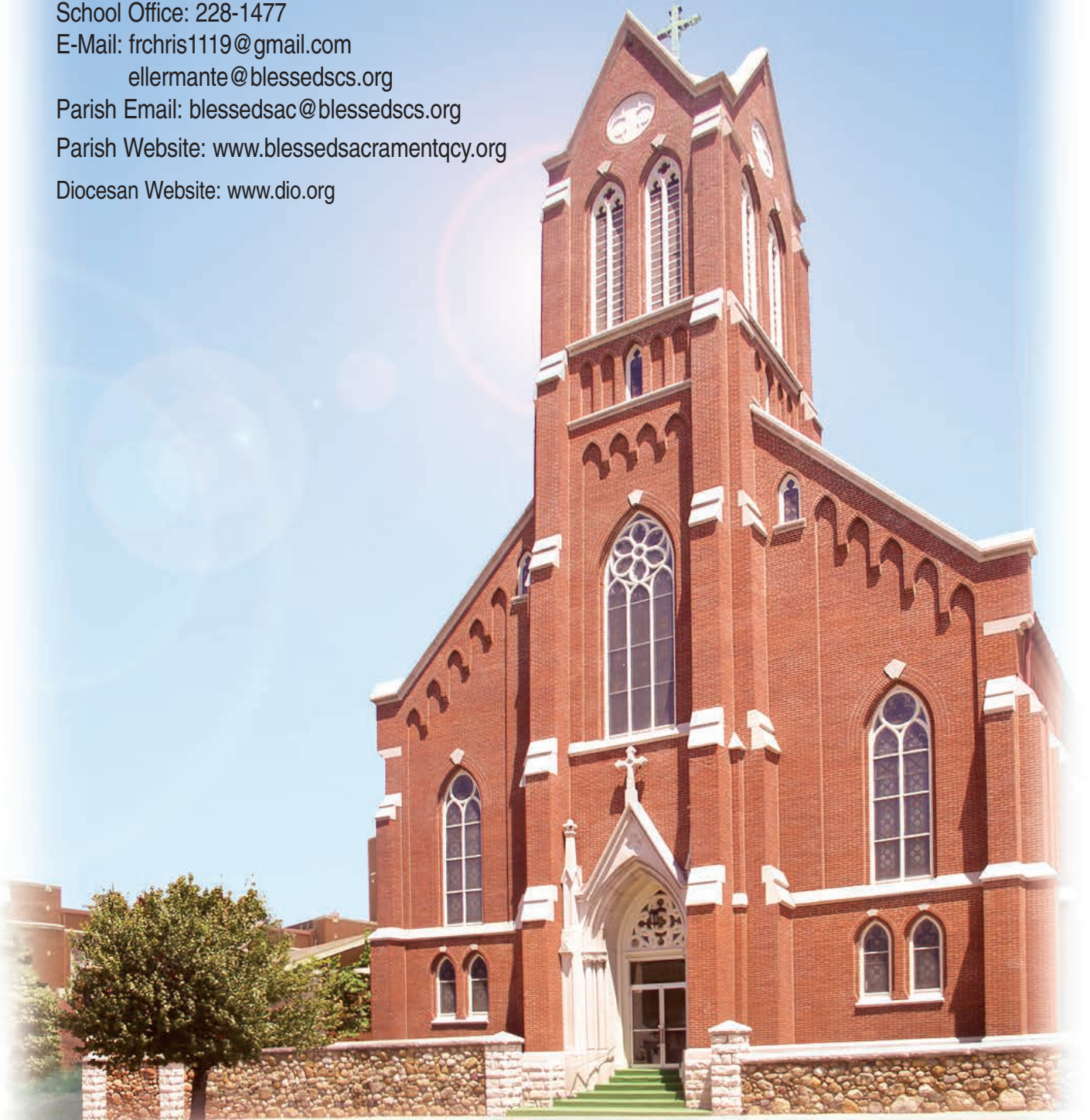

## School News

### Curriculum Mapping

We are very grateful for the professional development opportunities we have had this school year to map the science curriculum and align our teaching to the Next Generation Science Standards. The developers of these national science standards have determined that there are three distinct and equally important dimensions to learning science. These dimensions are combined to form each standard—or performance expectation—and each dimension works with the other two to help students build a cohesive understanding of science over time.

Since August, our teachers have worked monthly with education consultant, Elizabeth Brown, whose experience and curriculum mapping expertise has been invaluable. In April, Blessed Sacrament teachers participated in individual meetings to edit science maps and compare what they are teaching to the Next Generation Science Standards and this past week, teachers examined maps and reviewed standards as they looked for current gaps and redundancies. We will use this information to determine how we can increase our effectiveness and efficiency in teaching the science curriculum across grades PreK-8, with the goal of developing a seamless science curriculum preschool through eighth grade. We look forward to publishing and posting our maps on the school website for parents, stakeholders, parishioners, and future school families to be knowledgeable of what our students are learning in science within each grade. The mapping of other curricular content will continue next year and ensuing years, until all subjects are mapped and aligned to national learning standards.

We greatly appreciate the financial support we received from the Tracy Family Foundation and generous donations of parishioners that enabled us to have this valuable and necessary professional development opportunity!
