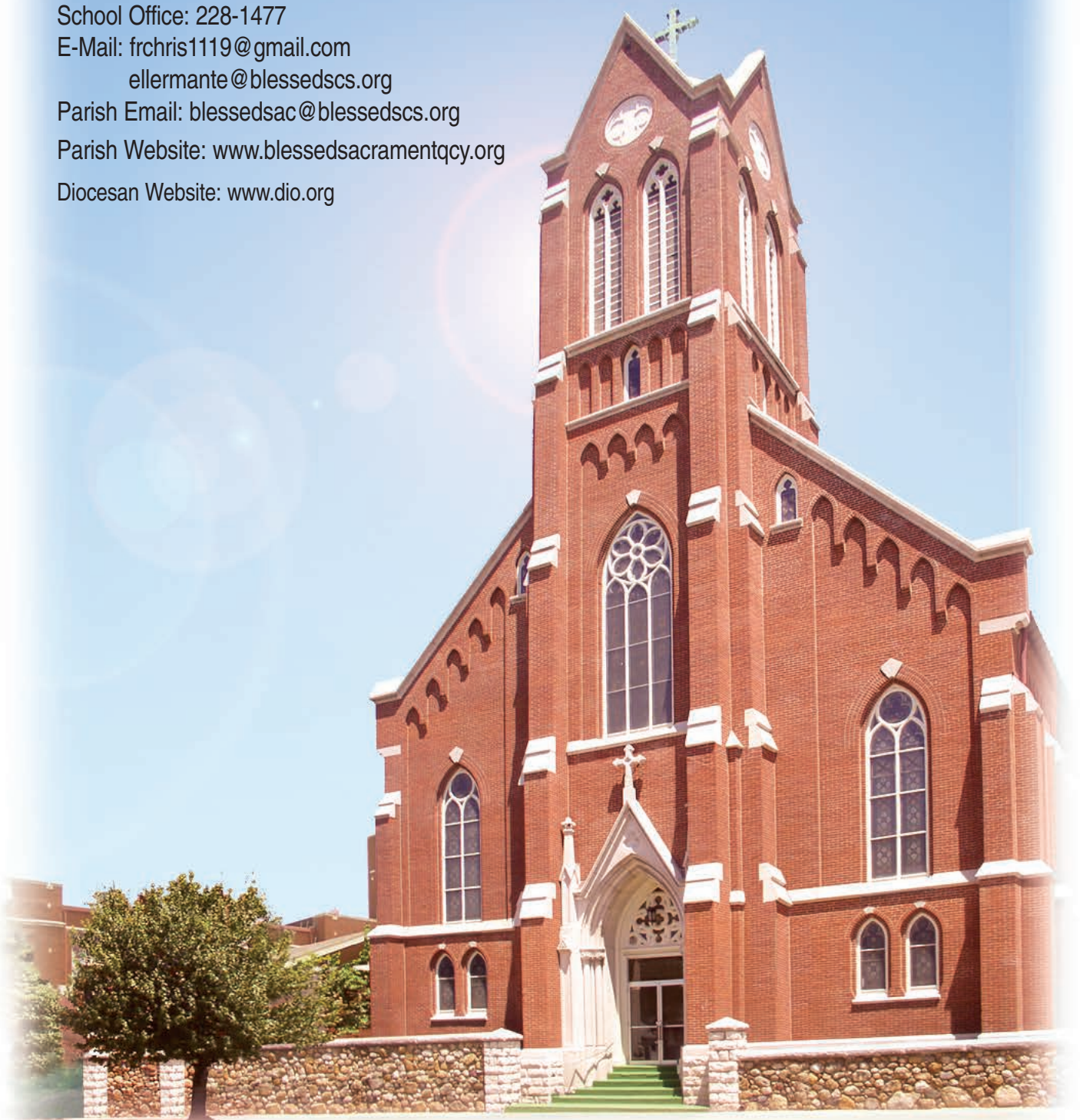

FATHER CHRIS'S COLUMN

**RESTORED ORDER OF THE
SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION**

Last year our Diocese held the Diocesan Synod which approved several recommendations to Bishop Paprocki for the future. One of these was to restore the order of Sacraments to Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. There is an article on the next page about this. What this means is starting in the school year of 2019-2020 our children will receive Confirmation and First Holy Communion from the Bishop at the same Mass in Third Grade. They will still receive First Reconciliation in Second Grade. Over the next several years our Eighth Graders will also receive Confirmation with them until we catch up. This means that our Second Graders this school year will not have First Communion but our Eighth Graders will have Confirmation. I will spend some time at Masses explaining the thinking behind this decision and how we will prepare our students for these Sacraments.

Indeed, all parishes within the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois are restoring the Original Order of the Sacraments of Initiation between 2019-2025.

In the early Church, the person was immersed into the waters of Baptism, anointed with chrism, and shared in the Eucharistic meal as part of a single event. Over time, and for many reasons, the celebration of these three sacraments became separated from one another. In the renewal stemming from the Second Vatican Council, the Church was asked to more clearly set forth the intimate connection of Confirmation with the whole of Christian initiation. This original order also helps us recognize that sharing in the Eucharist completes our initiation into the Church and that it is Eucharist which is the “source and summit of our faith.”
