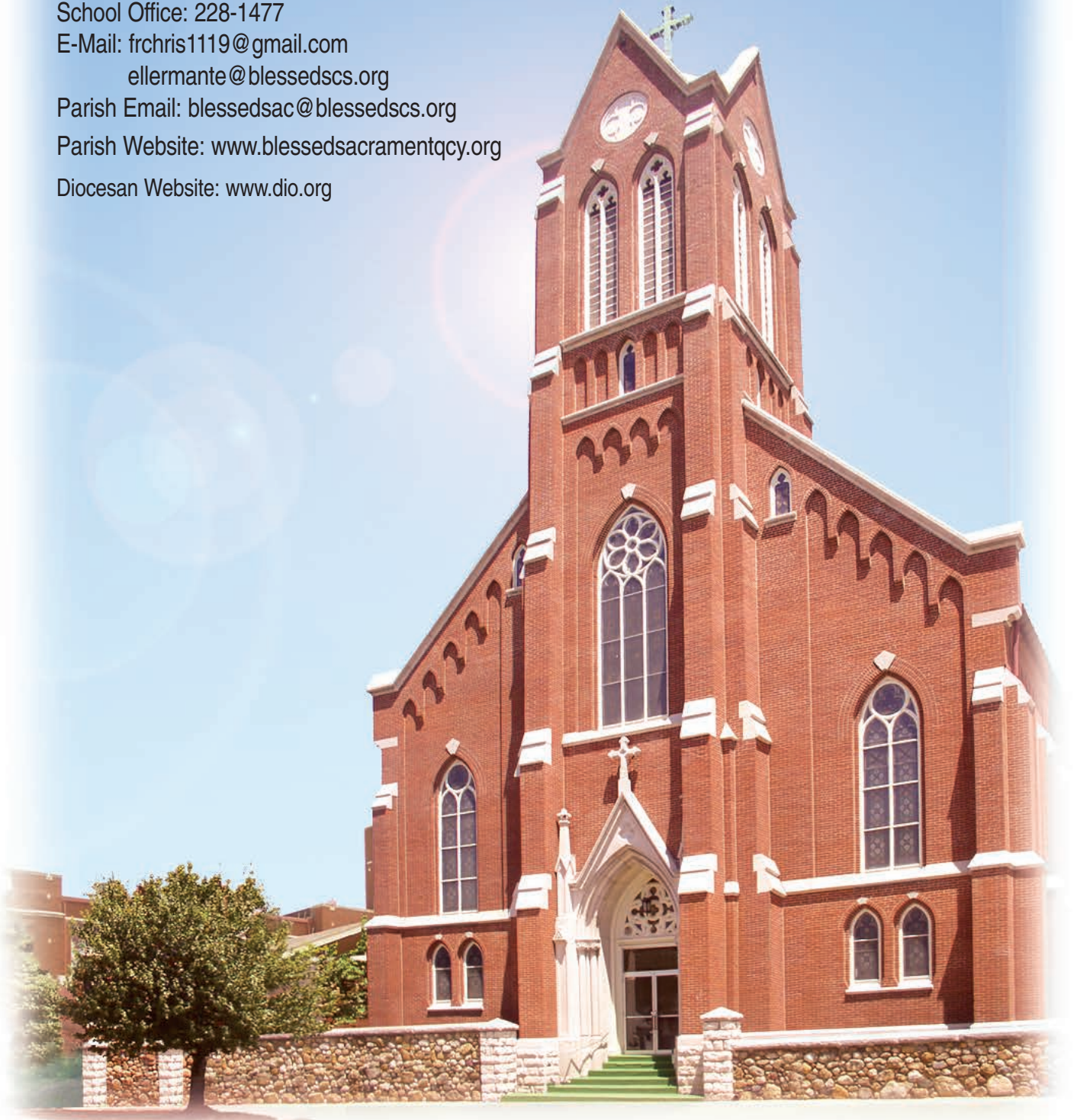

Quincy Catholic Elementary Schools' Curriculum Mapping

In January, teachers from Blessed Sacrament, St. Dominic, St. Francis, and St. Peter continued working together on their science curriculum maps with Pre-K, kindergarten, 1st grade and 2nd grade teachers meeting as grade levels teams to add agreed upon details to their maps. These curriculum maps contain seven components: standards, essential questions, content, skills, assessment, resources, and technology. Over the next few months, information explaining each component will be shared.

Standards:

- Illinois Early Learning and Development Standards (Pre-K)
- Next Generation Science Standards (Kindergarten - 8th grade)
- Curriculum aligned with state and national standards

Essential Questions:

- Overarching questions that provide focus for the unit and guide instruction.
- Essential questions are aligned to the big ideas, concepts, or themes. "Why is this important?"

Examples:

Standards:

- Plants** K-LS1 From Molecules to Organisms: Structures and Processes

Essential Questions:

- Plants** How do plants grow and change?
