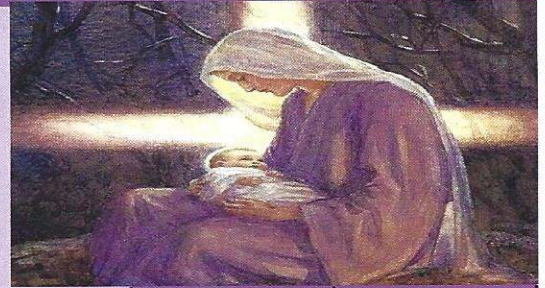


Laudato Si' Daily Reflections Calendar December 1 — December 31, 2020

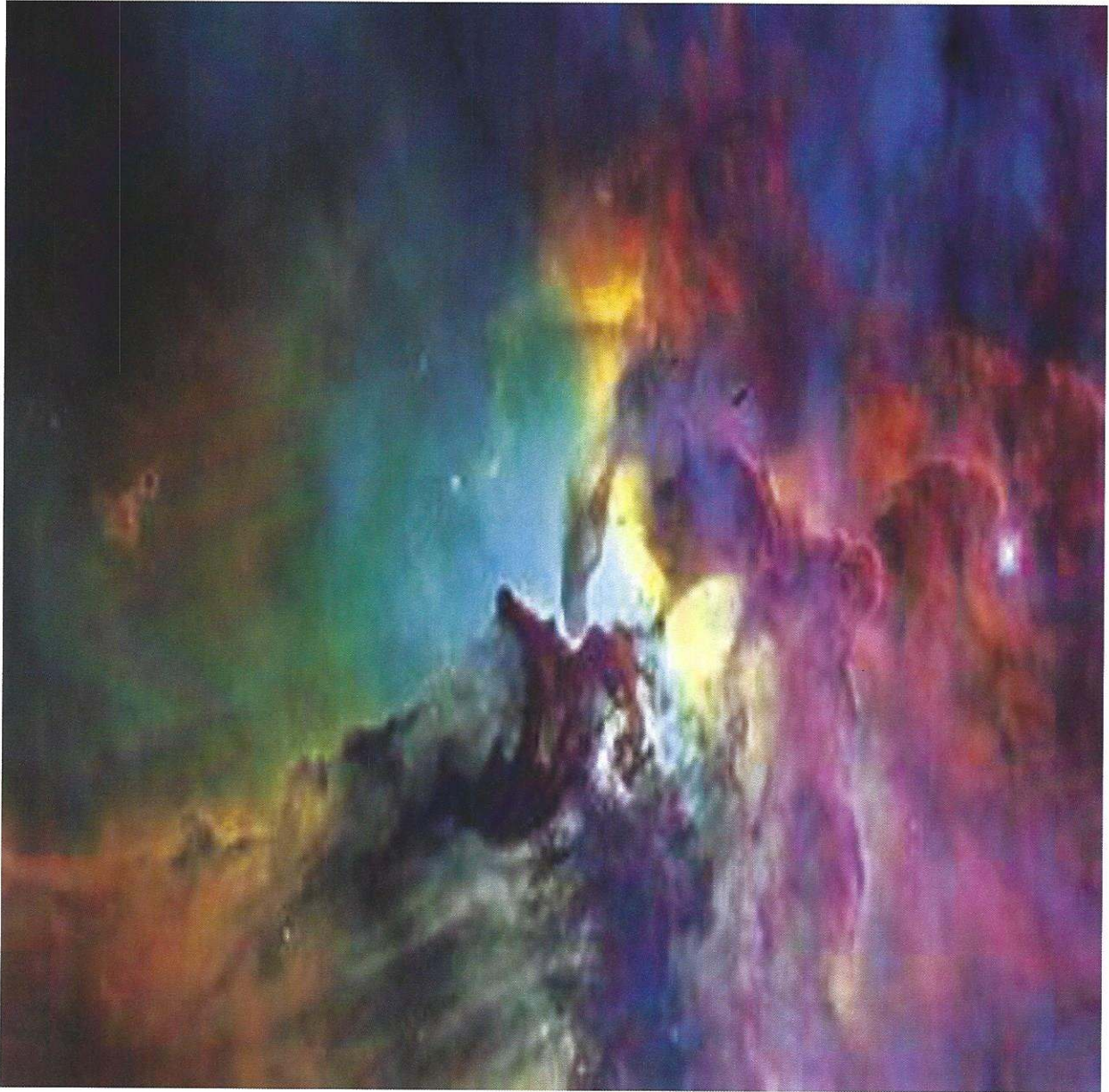
How we think God feels about us is critically important, because it greatly affects the way we feel about ourselves and the kind of relationship we have with God.
