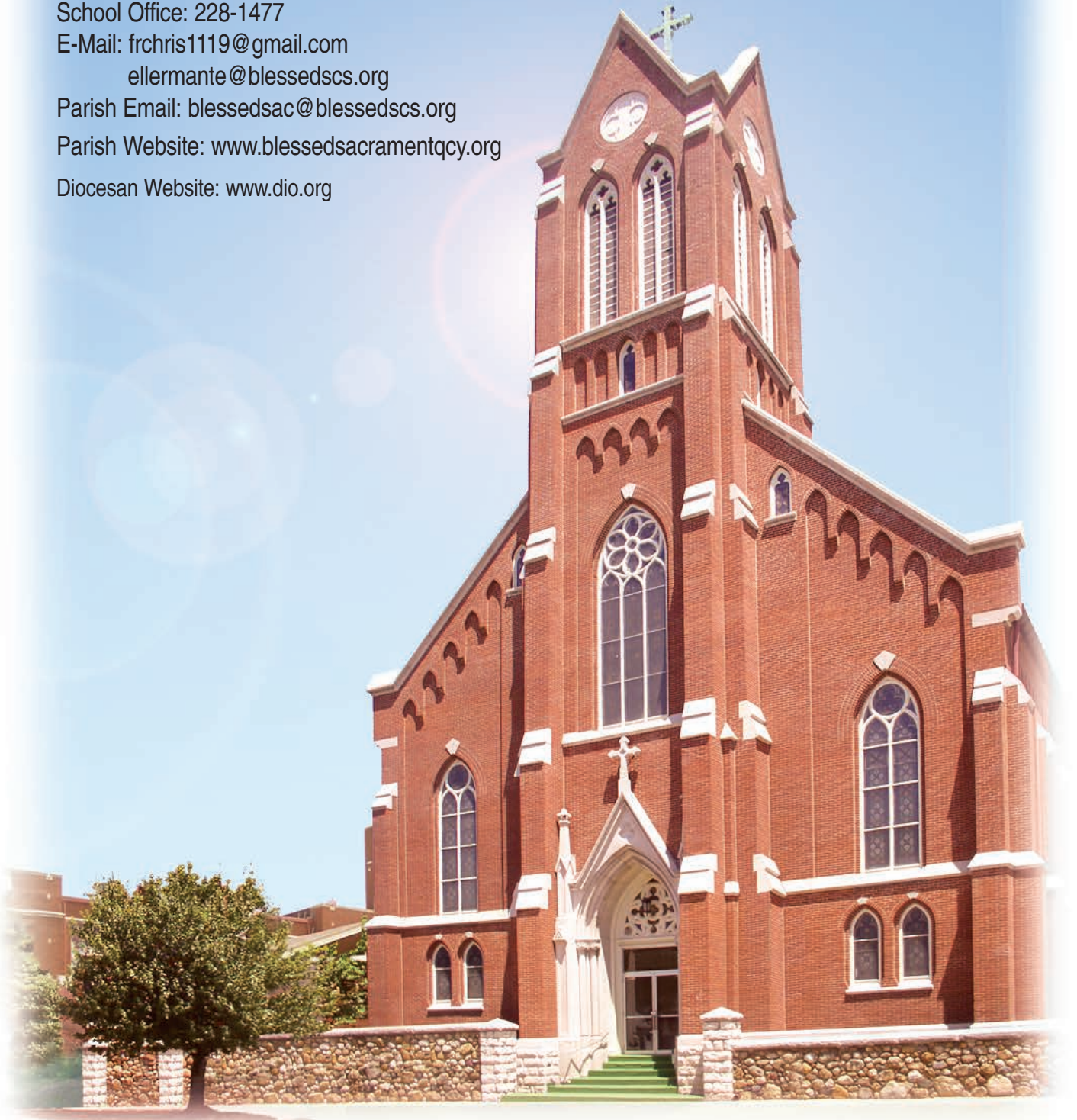

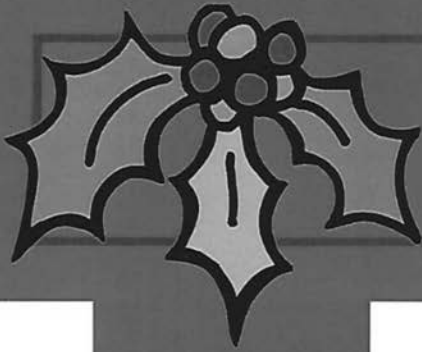
NOVEMBER WE REMEMBER
