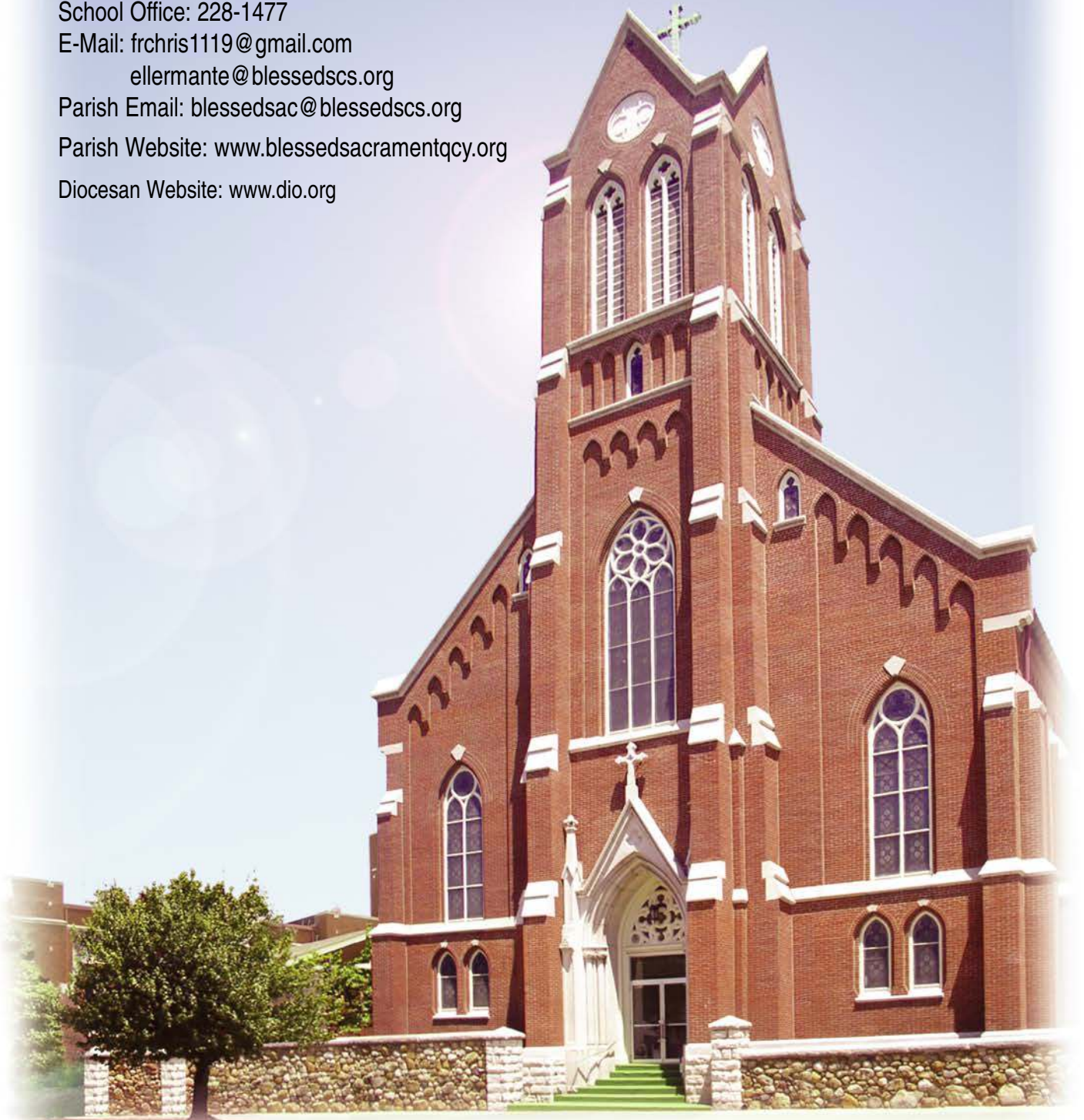

The Coronavirus Pandemic 2020

I would like to take this opportunity to share with you how Blessed Sacrament School's staff, families and students, who I could not be more proud of, met the challenges of "distance learning" with the Governor's executive order that all schools would close effective March 17 and what would later become the remainder of the school year. We were asked to provide learning opportunities for students, as well as make on-going personal connections with them in a manner "never been done before"...from a distance. We, as all educators across this country, were in the midst of unprecedented times and completely uncharted waters. But despite all of the uncertainty and fears of doing something that had **never** been done before, Blessed Sacrament's staff met this call to action and spent endless hours learning how to use technology such as Google "Hang-Out" and "Zoom" to have critically important face-to-face contact and provide opportunities for students to see each other. They utilized a number of digital resources that enhanced "on-line" learning and "virtual" field trips became a favorite. They prayed together and challenged students to find God's loving messages in these challenging times. They prepared packets in an organized manner that enabled us to have four safe and successful "pick-ups" of learning materials. Our teachers did not limit times they would be available for support as they knew that each of their student's family situations were unique so they were responsive to students' and parents' email as early as 6:00 in the morning until as late as 11:30 at night.

Our families were equally amazing, and we cannot thank them enough for their love support, patience, and prayers. We especially appreciated that so many when feeling fear or overwhelmed felt comfortable to reach out via phone calls, texts or emails enabling us to ease their stresses during this time of so much uncertainty. Our Mom and Dad's Facebook page became a great place for parents to support each other as well as a location for the posting of many beautiful celebrations of what our students were doing in their learning and their explorations.

The VAST majority of our students were absolutely amazing. (We had a few that were challenged to engage in this manner, but we continued our outreach with empathy and understanding doing the best we could to motivate them.) Our students faced a lot of disappointments because the fourth quarter of the school year is typically filled with many special events such as Olympic Day, School Picnic, Junior Achievement-Biz Town and Financial Park in St. Louis, the Washington, D.C. trip for our 8th graders. But with the support of their families, our school staff and our parish family, they successfully completed this school year and have likely learned a lot about how faith, family and friends will get you through.
