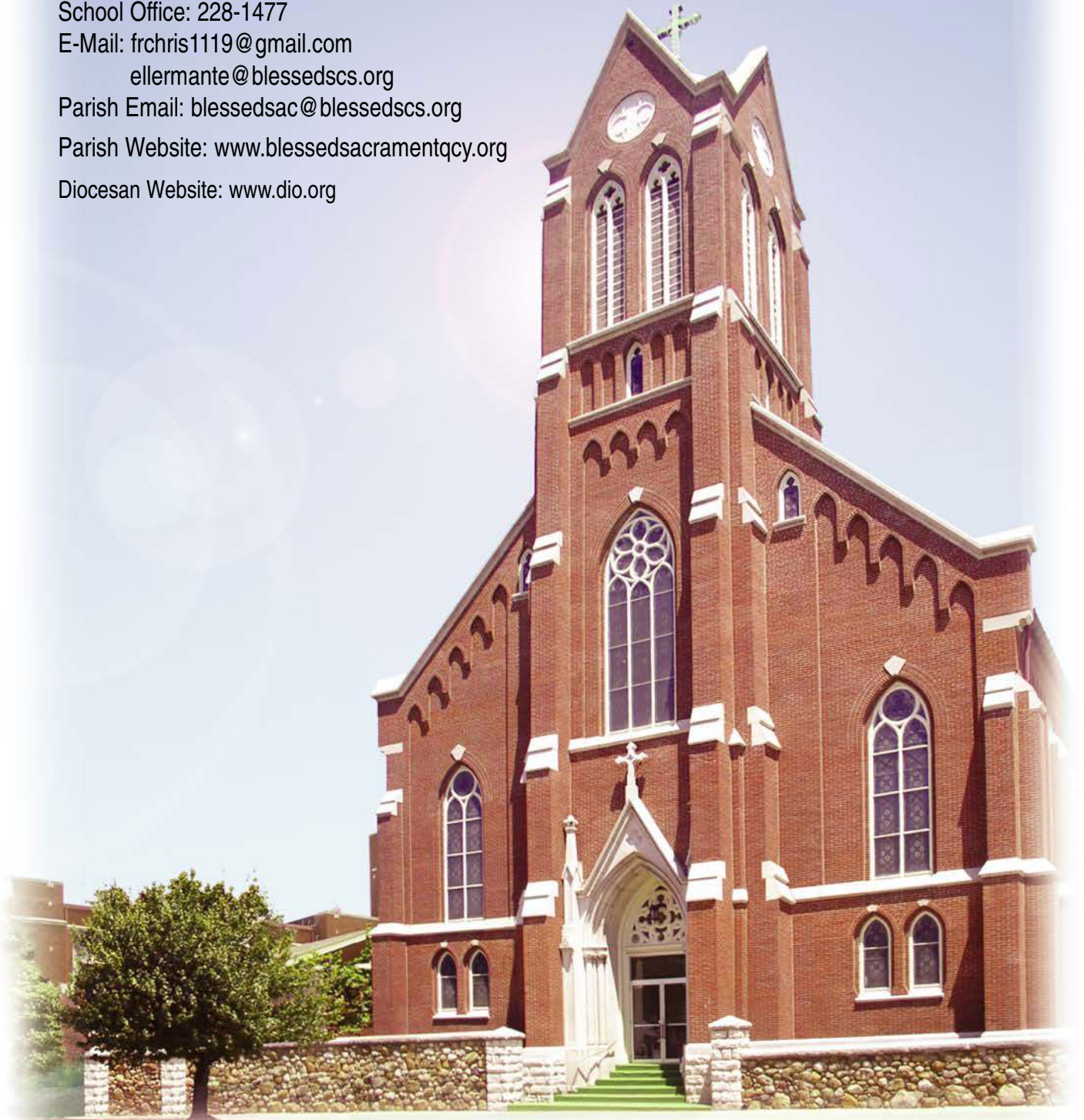

SO THANKFUL

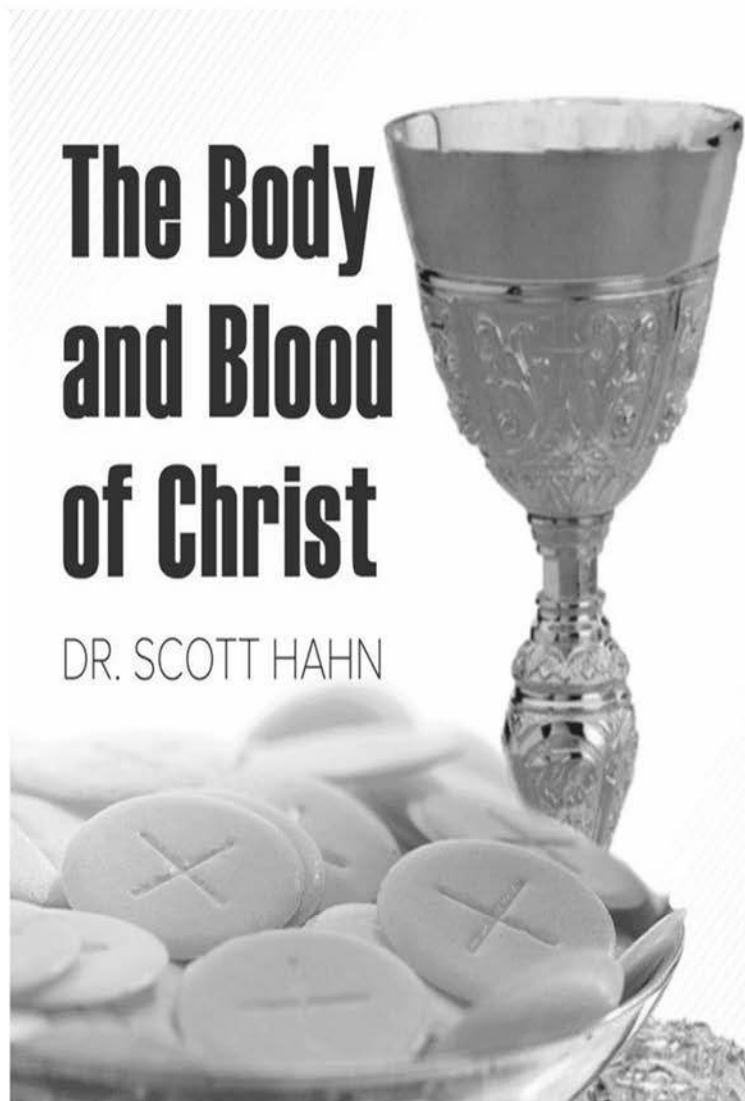
