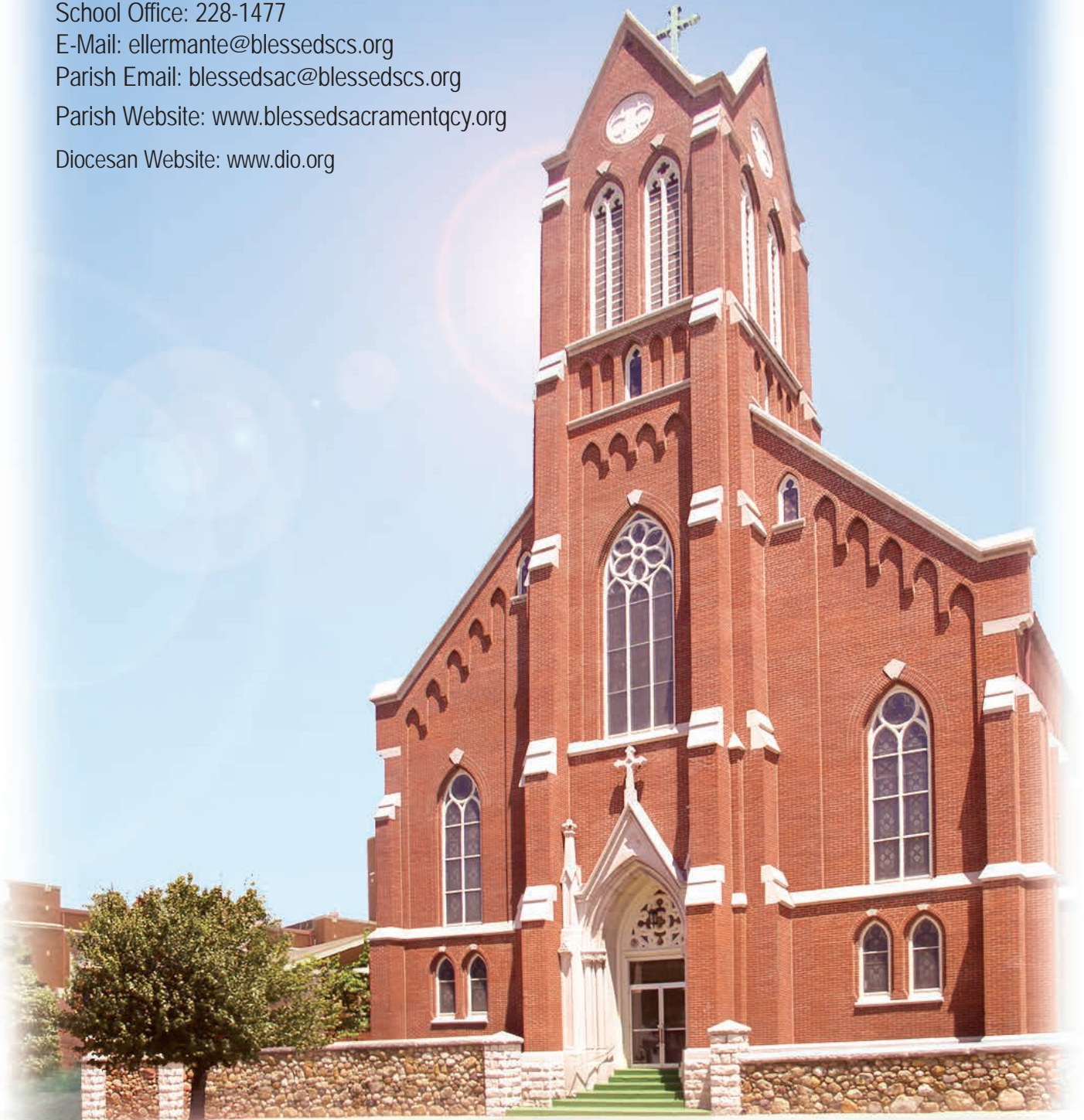

FATHER TOM'S COLUMN

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Today the Church celebrates the **26th Sunday in Ordinary Time**. In the Gospel today, Jesus addresses a challenge to the chief priests and elders of the people: "Tax collectors and prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God before you." Jesus uses the analogy of two sons who were both asked by their father to go out and work in the vineyard. The first son initially declined, but later changed his mind and went. The second son initially said "yes", but did not go. As evidenced by these two sons, our actions therefore speak much louder than our words. We Christian disciples have the great capacity to change our hearts towards the will of our heavenly Father. We should not give up on ourselves or others. We all have the great capacity for change and human growth.

In an effort to give Holy Communion to those not yet comfortable coming back to Mass, next week we will begin offering **10-person Communion Services each Sunday from 12:00-12:40 p.m.** We will allow a maximum of 10 persons (standing) in Church at a time to receive Holy Communion while being socially distanced. Each Communion Service will last approximately 5-6 minutes. Parish members can call the Parish Office to sign up for individual 10 minute blocks of time: (1) 12:00-12:10 p.m.; (2) 12:10-12:20 p.m.; (3) 12:20-12:30 p.m.; and (4) 12:30-12:40 p.m. These new Communion Services are being offered to bring the Body of Christ to those who have not been attending for fear of the Coronavirus. I ask those who have been attending Mass to continue attending Mass as normal. Our new Communion Services will begin **this Sunday, September 27**.

Our "**Septemberfest Raffle**" concludes in 3 days. Tickets are \$20 each (or 3 for \$50, or 8 for \$100). The final Septemberfest Drawing will be held this Wednesday, September 30. We invite parish members to consider purchasing the value of tickets of what you normally would have spent at Septemberfest. Thank you for helping share in the "generous spirit of Septemberfest" by buying and selling your Septemberfest Raffle tickets.

Finally, next Sunday, October 4 our parish Finance Council will present the **Annual Financial Report for Fiscal Year 2019-20**. Members of the Finance Council will make a brief presentation at each of our Sunday Masses. We thank the Finance Council for their good work in overseeing the financial operations of our parish.

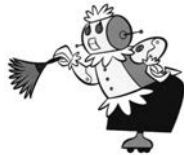

The Bishop's Scholarship \$10,000 To be eligible for consideration, a candidate must: 1) Belong to a parish in the Diocese of Springfield; 2) Apply to Quincy University and be admitted by March 15, 2021; 3) Enroll and submit a statement describing their involvement in their local parish, the Diocese, or the Catholic Church by April 15, 2021. **Apply at quincy.edu/apply**

This scholarship is subject to the University's stacking policy which caps all institutional aid at tuition. It is renewable for up to eight semesters of study as long as the recipient remains enrolled full-time and maintains a 3.3 grade point average at QU.
