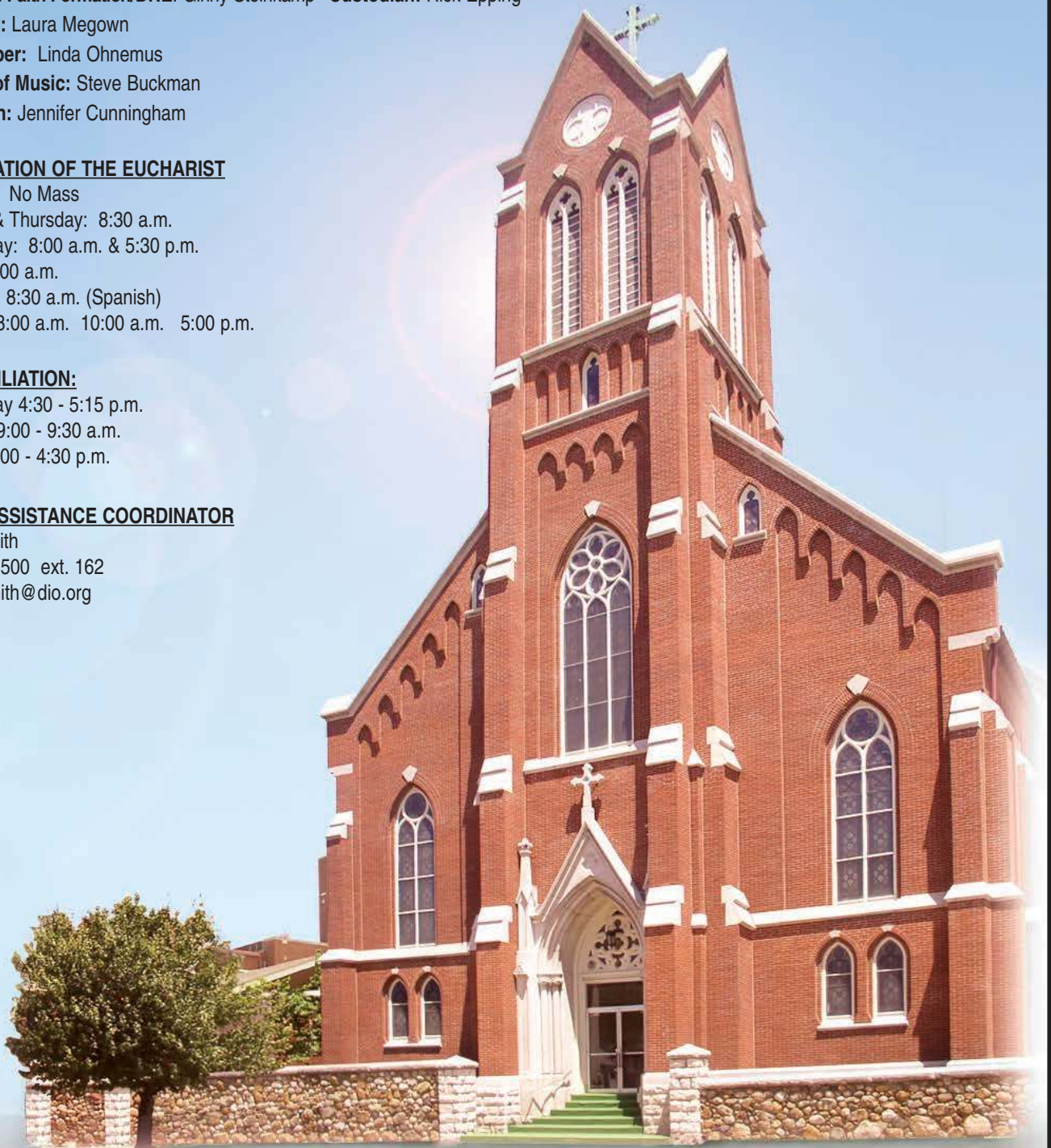

**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Today we celebrate the 3<sup>rd</sup> **Sunday of Lent**. In the gospel we hear the story of Jesus' cleansing of the Temple. He drove out the money changers because they had been making "my Father's house a marketplace". Sin has the same negative effect on us. We are all temples of the Holy Spirit, made in God's image and likeness. Yet sin has a way of polluting the house (us) in which our Father dwells. This Lent is an opportunity to do some house cleaning. What are the areas of my "temple" (life) that need cleansing?

The season of **Lent** should include the following elements for us to focus upon: (1) Fasting – giving up something we like; (2) Prayer; and (3) Charity – doing charitable works for others and donating money to charity.

This weekend our RCIA elect begin the **Scrutinies**. The Church teaches that the Scrutinies are "rites for self-searching and repentance ... The Scrutinies are meant to

uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect." We pray that our elect and candidates may join us throughout Lent to reflect on their own weaknesses and find healing in God's grace and mercy.

# The Scrutinies

## What are the Scrutinies?

At the 8:00 a.m. Mass this week, the readings for the Scrutinies were read. The Scrutinies are a rite of the Catholic Church meant “to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect” and “to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, and good” (RCIA, 141). It is important to remember though that the emphasis of the Scrutinies is not solely an examination of sinfulness but also a meditation of God’s mercy.

## What is the format of the Scrutinies?

Each Scrutiny begins with the Elect being invited forward with their sponsors to kneel down. The whole assembly then prays for them in silence. We then pray out loud Intercessions for the Elect. Next a Prayer of Exorcism is prayed that the Elect might be “freed from the power of the Evil One and protected on their journey.” Finally, there is the Laying On of Hands, this is meant to remind us of the Sacrament of Holy Orders. At this moment the priest or deacon calls

down the Spirit of Jesus to be with them and protect them. This is a preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism when the Catechumens will be anointed and participate in what is called the *Munera Christi*, or Jesus’ offices of PRIEST, Prophet, and King. Finally, the Elect are dismissed to reflect on the Word.

## Who participates in Scrutinies?

Those who were once called Catechumens, unbaptized people seeking the Sacraments of Initiation, and are now called the Elect participate in the Scrutinies. Candidates, or baptized individuals seeking full communion with the Catholic Church, do not participate. This is to recognize that they have been saved and cleansed by the waters of Baptism. The Scrutinies though are a time for us to all reflect on the two areas of emphasis. Firstly, that we are all sinners who have fallen short of God’s will for our lives. Secondly, to reflect on God’s mercy and our need for the saving love of Jesus Christ.
