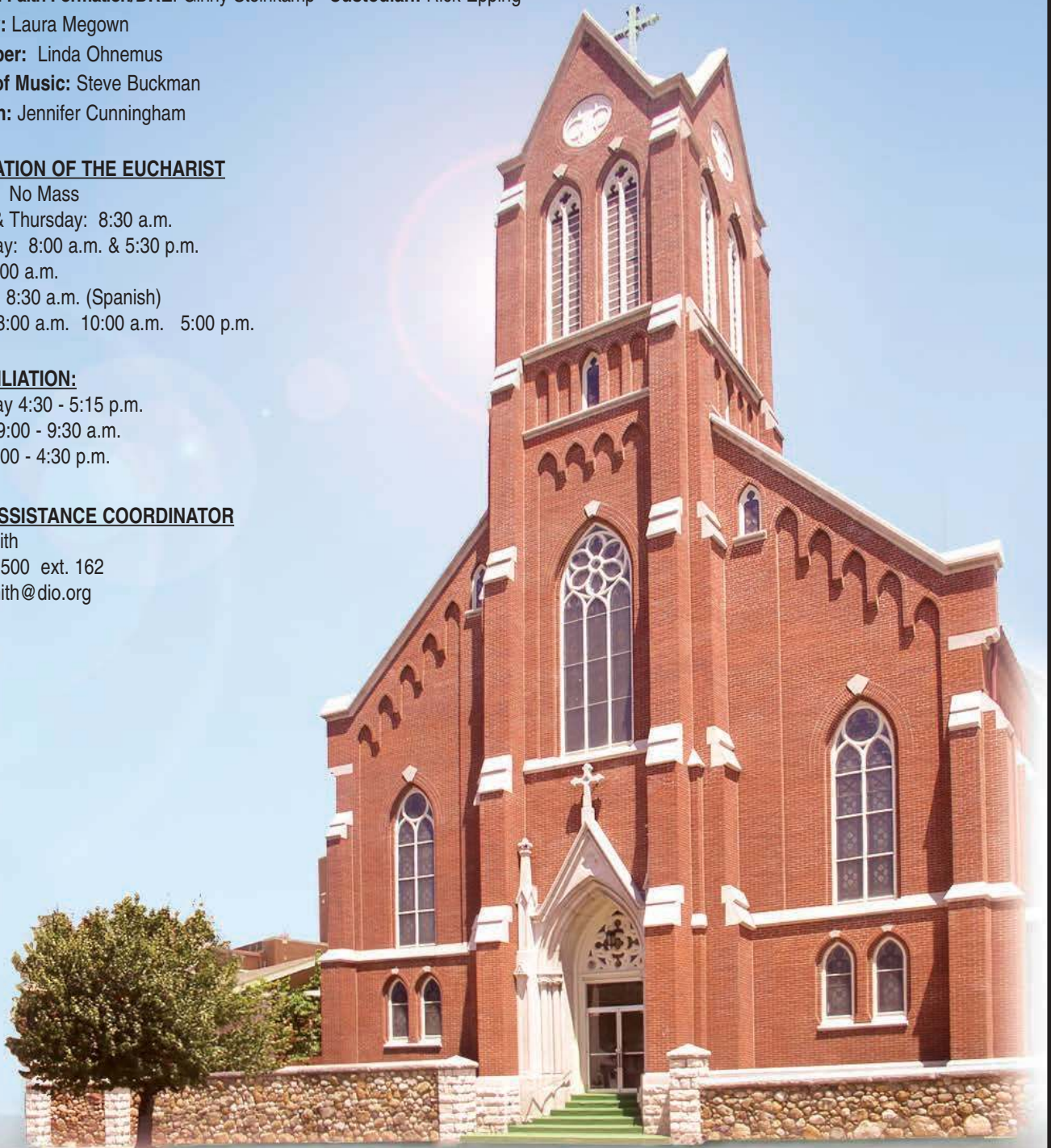

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we will have **5th and 6th Grade and New) Altar Server Commissioning**. Our 5th and 6th Grade students have been busy this past week in attending altar server training sessions with myself, Deacon Terry, and Dick McKinney. It will be our pleasure as a parish to officially commission them next Sunday at the 10:00 a.m. Mass.

QCES (Quincy Catholic Elementary Schools) has launched its "Everybody Wins" Mega Raffle. Tickets can now be purchased from nearly 1,000 QCES and QND families. **Tickets will be on sale today (Sunday, April 25) after all Masses.** Top prizes will be drawn at the St. Francis Parish Picnic on Saturday, June 12, starting at 7:00 p.m.

During the months of April and May I would like to invite parish members to consider submitting their names for **Open Seats** on the 2021-22 **BSS Education Council, Pastoral Council, Finance Council, and Stewardship Committee**. For more information please contact myself, BSS Principal Christie Bliven, Pastoral Council Chair Joe Bordewick, Finance Council Chair Michelle Miller, or Stewardship Committee Chair Amber Hendrian.

We received from the Springfield Diocese an **ACSA (Annual Catholic Services Appeal)** update. For our \$90,536 goal, we are **currently behind \$40,691**. Gratefully our average pledge **has increased 49%** and that is absolutely outstanding! Thank you for these very generous pledges!!! Unfortunately we have had 38% fewer persons pledging this year, likely due to our smaller Sunday Mass attendance since the beginning of the COVID pandemic. Blessed Sacrament Parish will be required to pay the difference by June 30. If you have not yet made a pledge, please consider doing so by June 30. The following are our current 2020-21 ACSA pledge numbers, in comparison to last year's 2019-20 pledges.

ACSA 2020-21: 101 pledges: \$49,845.75

Total Paid: \$43,262.75 Avg. Pledge: \$494

ACSA 2019-20: 164 pledges: \$54,493.00

Total Paid: \$54,084.00 Avg. Pledge: \$332

One of the local charitable organizations I recommend parish members to consider volunteering their time is **Horizons Soup Kitchen and Food Pantry**. Blessed Sacrament currently volunteers there at the lunch hour on the **2nd Friday and 4th Thursday of every month** from 11:30 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Our parish donated our Holy Thursday collection to Horizons for a gift of \$790. Horizons is currently working hard to develop a plan to return to indoor dining. I have asked our **Parish Garden** members to donate generous portions of the fresh vegetables they grow to serve our neighbors at Horizons. If you would like to be a lunchtime volunteer, please contact Chris Wiemelt through the Parish Office.

Finally, Blessed Sacrament has a new **Parish Mission Statement**, which the Pastor's Cabinet and I have been developing over the last year. I am happy to have a concise statement to direct our parish's vision and energies:
