Today we celebrate the **3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time**. In the gospel story today Jesus returns to the synagogue in his home town of Nazareth. He picks up the scroll and reads the passage from Isaiah, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor." Jesus sits down and concludes, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." Although it has been over 2000 years since he read this passage, Jesus' fulfillment of this message continues today in our very midst.

This weekend (January 25/26) the Universal Church celebrates the "**Sunday of the Word of God.**" The Church celebrates the importance of the Sacred Scriptures in our everyday lives of faith. 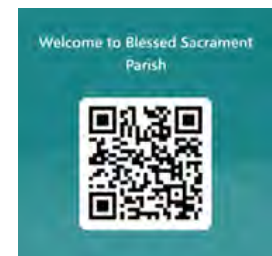
