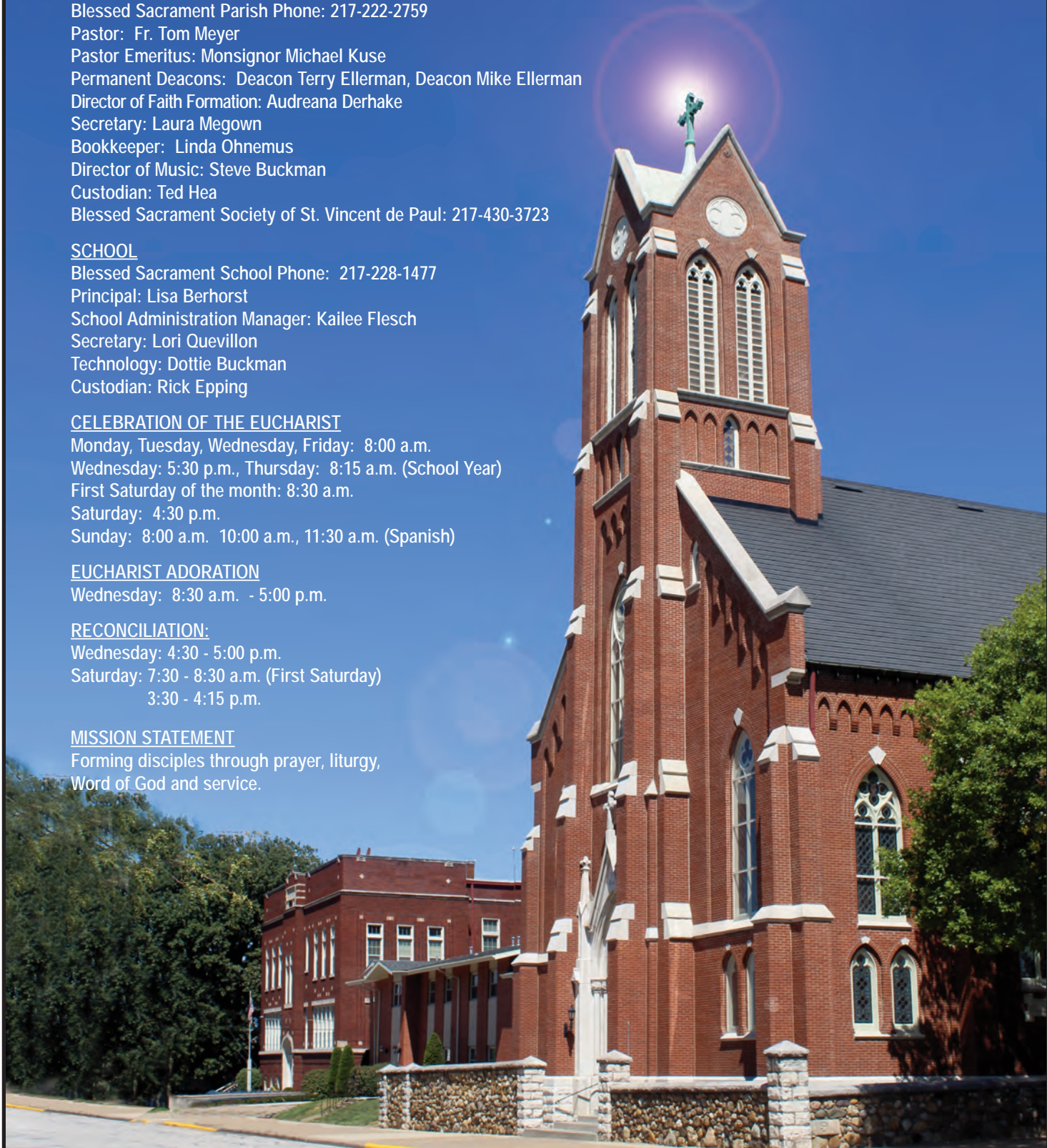

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the **6th Sunday in Ordinary Time**. In the gospel story today we hear Luke's version of the *Beatitudes*. In Luke's version it is called the "Sermon on the Plain." In this version we hear four "Beatitudes" and four "Woes". The "woes" are reserved for ...those who are rich, those who are filled now, those who laugh now, and those who receive spoken praises. According to the New American Bible, the "woes...threaten God's profound displeasure on those so blinded by their present fortunate situation that they do not recognize and appreciate the real values of God's kingdom." We take this opportunity to "appreciate" the blessings in our lives, while passing some of those blessings on to those less fortunate.

In the month of January we received two major gifts - one for \$5,000 and another for \$2,000 - toward building our **Sister Parish School Security Wall**. Because of these very generous gifts, we are now **only \$636 away** from completing our St. Antoine School Security Wall. Thank you so very much for the generosity of our two anonymous donors. And thank you to all of our members who have been contributing toward the wall over the last year. I am so very proud of your amazing generosity to our Sister Parish!

Please mark your calendars and considering registering now for our **2nd Annual Blessed Sacrament Trivia Night** to help support our **Sister Parish** of St. Antoine in Haiti. The date is **Friday, February 28 at the Gathering Space**, with Trivia starting at 6:30 p.m. sharp. Cost is \$160 per team for up to 8 players. **BYO** food and drinks. There will be a 50-50 raffle. Dear Brothers in Christ,

In our Fourth Diocesan Synod, it was declared that we live as disciples who "make a conscious, firm decision, carried out in action, to be followers of Jesus Christ." One way that, as Catholic gentlemen, we can live out this declaration is by becoming an active member of the Knights of Columbus.

This exemplary order of Catholic men was founded in 1882 by a simple parish priest who had the vision and foresight to establish an organization that would provide Catholic men the opportunity to live out their faith through charitable works, care for their families and defense of the Catholic faith. Today, the Knights of Columbus are over 2 million members strong and serve not only in the 63 councils in this diocese, but in 16 countries across the globe. This local, national and international brotherhood of men provides a strong moral example in an age when our society promotes secularism over sacrificial service. Last year this fraternity of practical Catholic gentlemen donated more than \$185 million and 50 million hours to charity through affiliated councils in the United States, in addition to providing its members the opportunity to share a fraternal brotherhood with men of similar values and beliefs.
