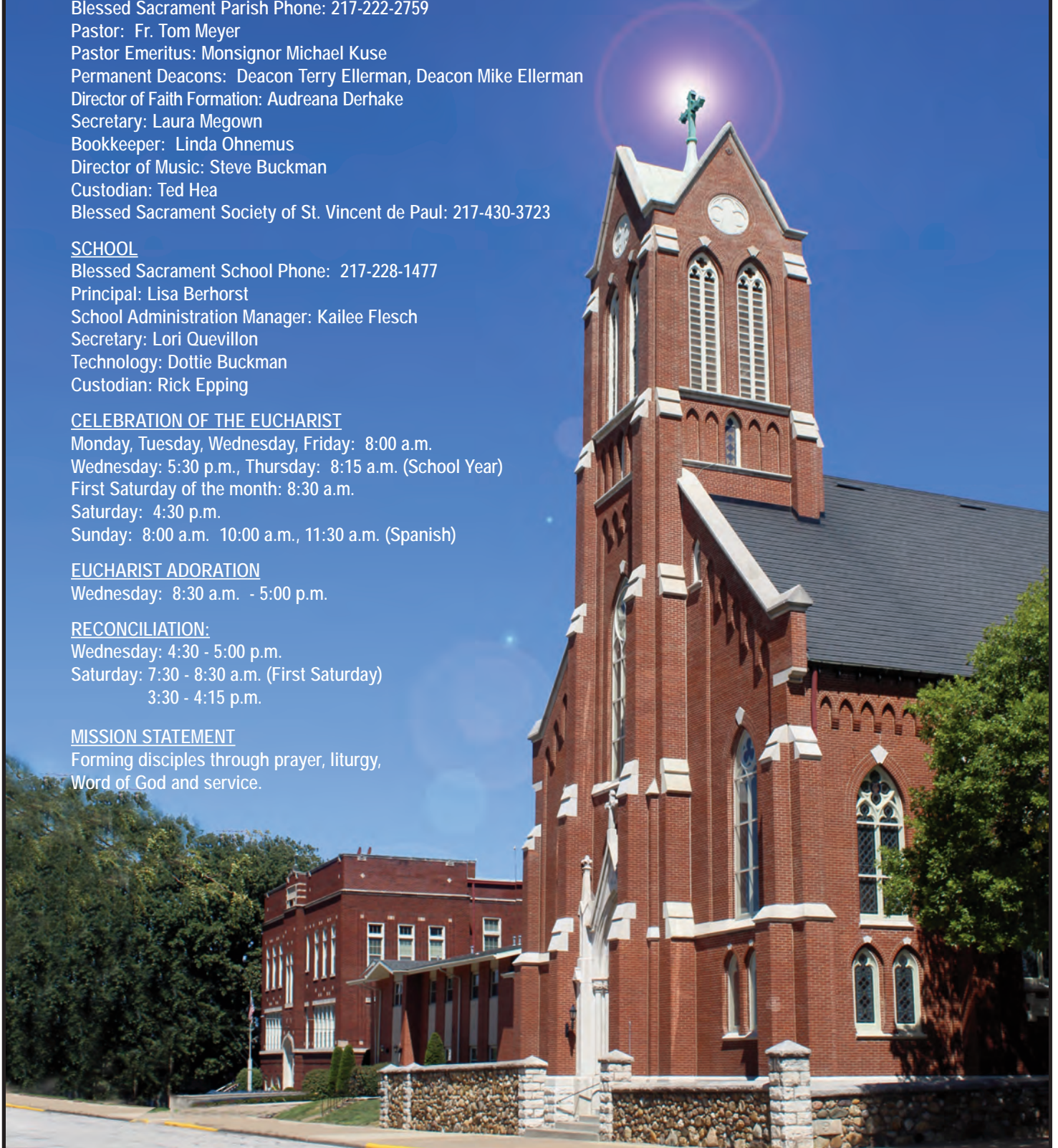

Today we celebrate the 7<sup>th</sup> **Sunday in Ordinary Time**. In the gospel today we hear Jesus say, "Love your enemies," and "For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you." The love and respect we offer to others, even to those who have been unkind to us, will not go unrewarded.

Please plan to attend our **2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Blessed Sacrament Trivia Night** to help support our **Sister Parish** of St. Antoine in Haiti. The date is this upcoming **Friday, February 28 at the Gathering Space**, with Trivia starting at 6:30 p.m. sharp. Cost is \$160 per team for up to 8 players. BYO food and drinks. There will be a 50-50 raffle. Childcare available onsite. Registrations due by Wednesday, February 26!! Teams can pay at the Parish office, online, or at the door (register by February 26.)

This upcoming Tuesday, February 25 at 5:30 p.m. we celebrate **1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation for all of our 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade students**. Please pray for our 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade students that they might have a wonderful first encounter with the power of God's mercy in their lives.

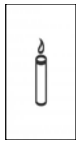

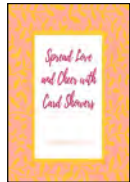
