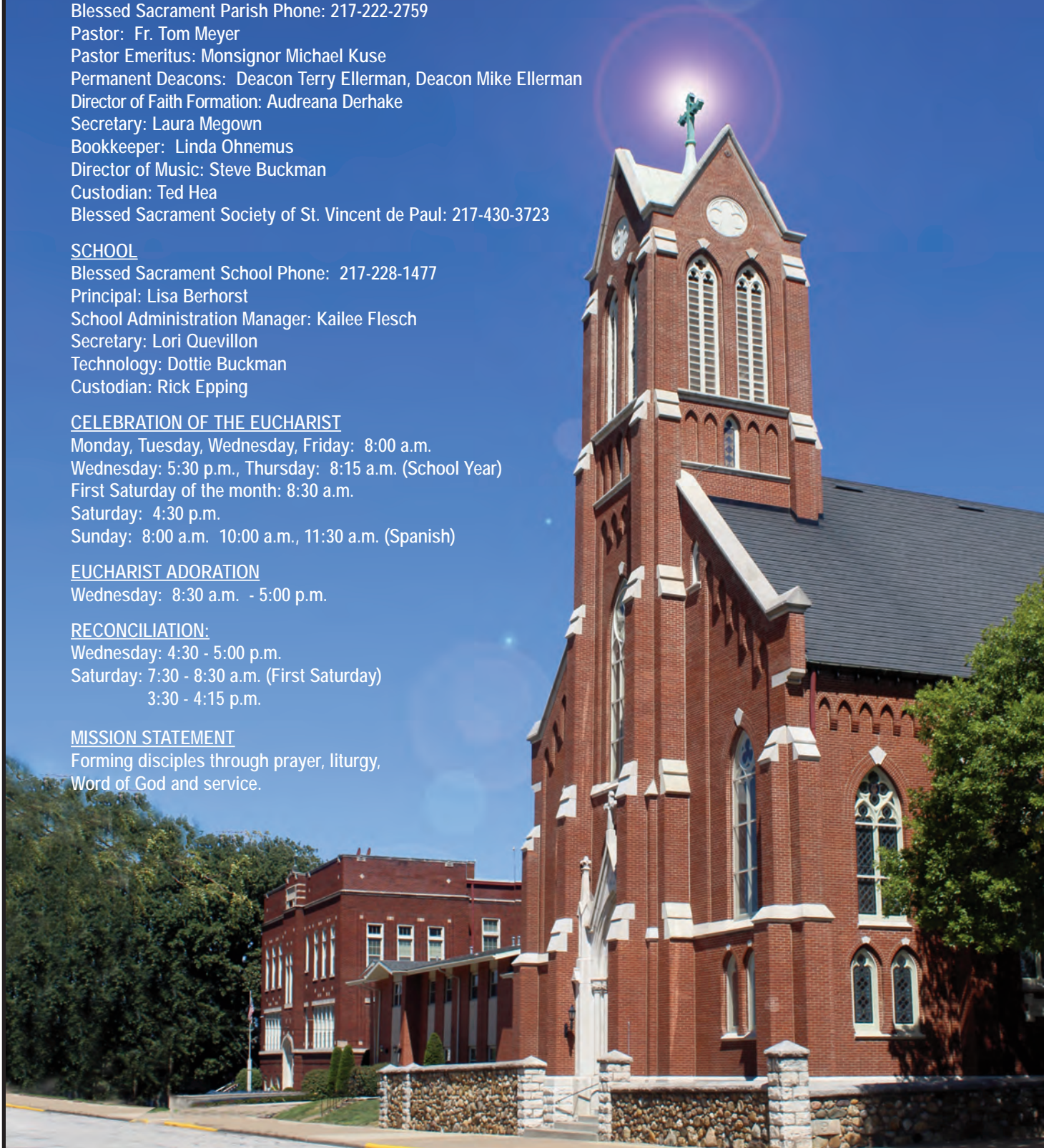

From the Pastor’s Desk

Today we celebrate the **5th Sunday in Ordinary Time**. In the gospel story today Jesus initiates the miraculous catch of fish. The disciples had been fishing all night long and had caught nothing. Jesus encourages them, “Put out into deep water.” When we are challenged to find “a catch” in our own everyday lives, we try to find solutions that go deeper to the root of our problems. Simple solutions without depth catch very little.

This weekend (February 8 -9) at all Masses we will celebrate our annual **Blessing for those Celebrating significant wedding anniversaries**. Our Parish Office is coordinating the details of this blessing. Please feel free to contact our Parish Office if you have any questions.

This weekend (February 8 - 9) we will celebrate the **Commissioning of our New 4th Grade Altar Servers**. Our 4th Grade class is one of our largest classes in Blessed Sacrament School. We are so very blessed that many of them have agreed to be our altar servers. We welcome them to this beautiful ministry next week of serving the Lord at the altar.

At the recommendation of Bishop Paprocki, in five weeks (March 8-9) we will be inviting parish members who participate in **Electronic giving to have the opportunity to place an Offertory Card, “I Give Electronically,”** into the Sunday Collection Basket on a weekly basis. 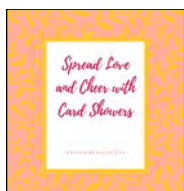

Quincy Catholic School Chess Tournament

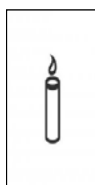
