**From the Pastor's Desk**

Today we celebrate the 3<sup>rd</sup> **Sunday of Lent**. In the gospel we hear Jesus' exhortation to repent. Jesus uses the parable of the fig tree to demonstrate that he will give us every opportunity to change our ways. When we engage in true repentance we are certain to bear good fruit. If the repentance and fruit do not come, the "gardener" will return later for the "cutting".

We have recently received a \$676 check to officially **Complete our Sister Parish School Security Wall!** We sent our first payment on the wall last February 2024. In just 13 months we have now completed a **\$29,556 Security Wall** for our Sister Parish School. That is truly amazing!!! I want to thank all who generously gave toward the Security Wall over the last 13 months, including our own school children, anonymous donors, and Trivia Night participants. With your generosity the students at St. Antoine School have a new layer of protection in addition to their many guardian angels who watch over them day by day.

The season of **Lent** should include the following elements for us to focus upon: (1) Fasting -giving up something we like; (2) Prayer; and (3) Charity - doing charitable works for others and donating money to charity. Blessed Sacrament will provide several liturgical and devotional opportunities each week during Lent to assist you in your spiritual growth during this Lenten season.

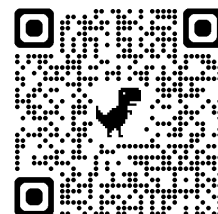
