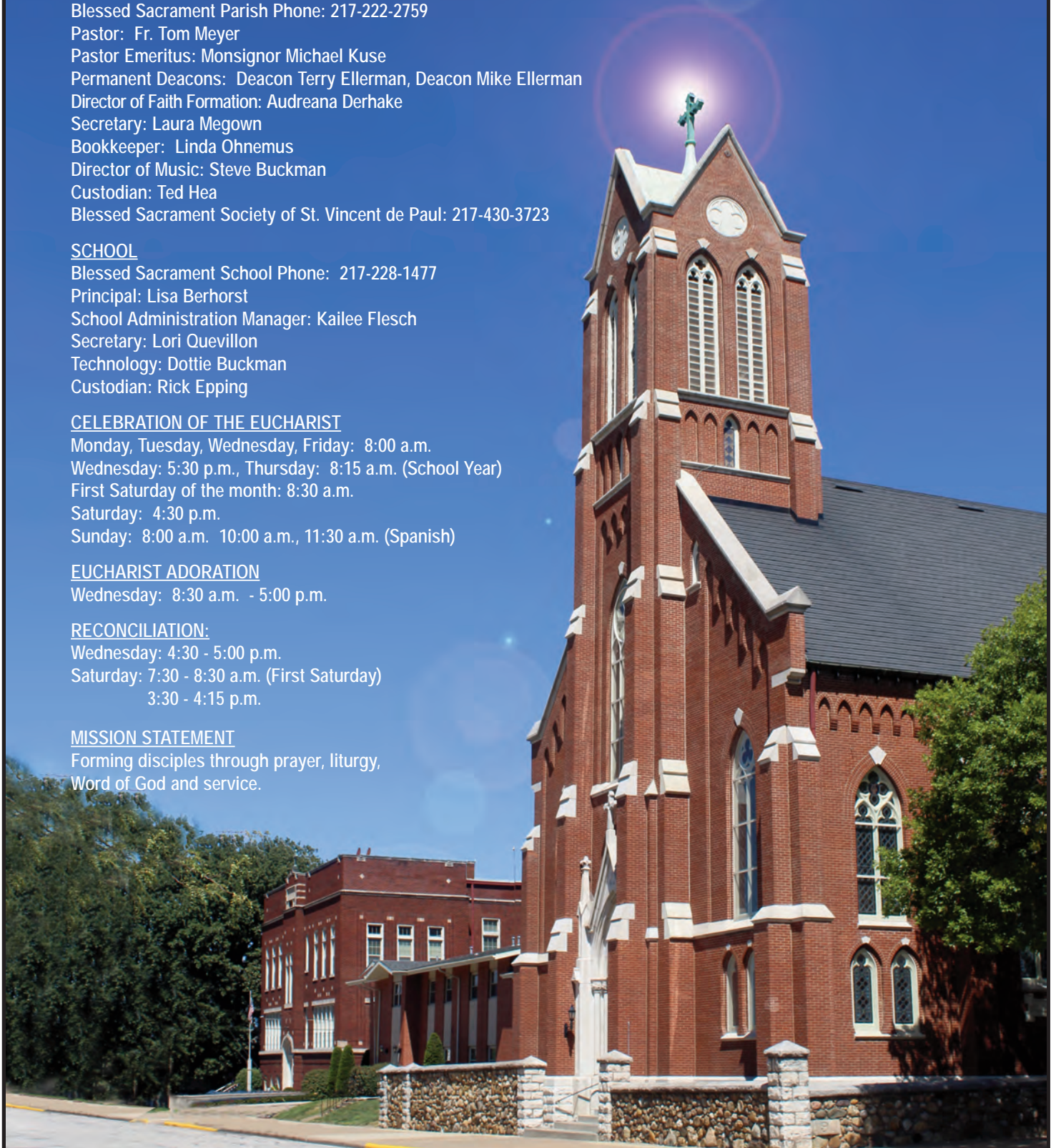

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Today we celebrate the **5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent**. In the gospel we hear the story of the woman caught in adultery. In an attempt to trap him, the Pharisees and scribes ask Jesus what should be done with her. Jesus replies, "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." Ultimately her accusers leave one by one. Jesus extends to this woman a beautiful message of mercy, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin anymore." May we seek this same beautiful message of mercy from the heart of Christ Jesus.

Yesterday (**Saturday, April 5**) was the celebration of the **Sacraments of Confirmation/1<sup>st</sup> Communion for our 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Students** at the Springfield Cathedral. Today (Sunday, April 6) they will have their parish celebration at our own 10:00 a.m. Mass here at Blessed Sacrament. Please join me in giving praise and thanksgiving to God for the sacraments that He has bestowed upon His children.

The season of **Lent** should include the following elements for us to focus upon: (1) Fasting -giving up something we like; (2) Prayer; and (3) Charity - doing charitable works for others and donating money to charity.
